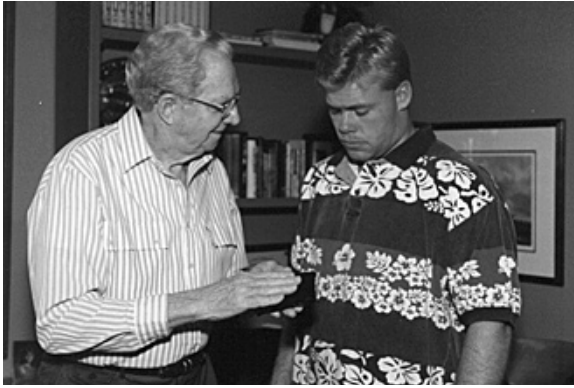
3.) God loves us.

Psalms 4:5



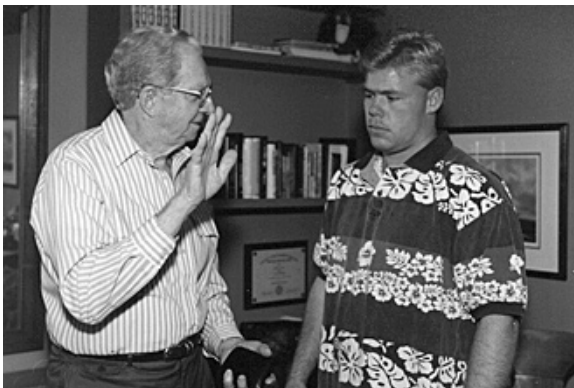
5.) Our sin separates us from God. We cannot get rid of our sin by our good works.

Romans 6:23



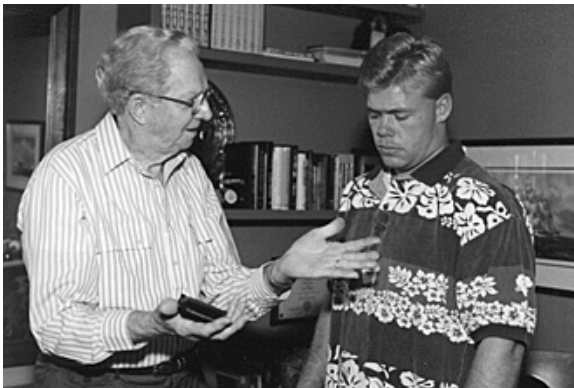
7.) Let this hand represent the Lord Jesus Christ. He had no sin. He was perfect.
